## *A Call To Action*

Since its establishment in 1785, Dauphin County has been home to countless ordinary citizens who have done extraordinary feats. All have had one common thread: A willingness to sacrifice their own safety and well-being to protect their fellow citizens and the American way of life.

Now, more than 220 years later, a movement has begun to honor these brave heroes.

Conceived by the Honorable Ronald S. Marsico and a collection of dedicated public servants, civic and community leaders, the Dauphin County Heroes Grove is being developed on a tract of land in Lower Paxton Township behind the Friendship Center. Phase 1 is complete and features an amphitheatre which sets the stage for remembrance and memorial ceremonies that will honor veterans, emergency responders, law enforcement personnel and ordinary citizens who have demonstrated their dedication to our communities, commonwealth, and country. It is also the setting for a series of educational seminars, festivals and concerts.

Dauphin County Heroes Grove has been endorsed by local, county and state law enforcement groups, veteran organizations, volunteer firefighters, and emergency medical service personnel.
